4.2 Beach Marina Reconstruction Project Update

Public Works Engineer II Kelly Peterich presented on progress of the Beach Marina Reconstruction, reporting no problems and timely progression of all phases.

4.3 Harbor Marina Repairs Update

Mr. Peterich said the Harbor Marina repairs are almost ready to go out to bid and will most likely begin work in February 2026 with estimated completion in 2027.

4.4 Seminole Street Boat Launch Repairs Update

Mr. Peterich said the contractor is mobilizing next Monday and repairs will be completed in October. In response to questions clarifications were provided on the boat launch as well as the upcoming speed boat race.

5. Director's Report

Marine and Aviation Director Mike McDonald said Council has approved the first round of incremental rate increases per Board recommendations and shifting from the Passenger Count rate to the Per Foot rate. He said the county and state have approved a cumulative \$13.5 million in grants for the Beach Marina project.

The Board discussed the kayak launch area at Seminole Ramp and an additional area that could be utilized as such.
