

ORDINANCE NO. 9679-23

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CLEARWATER,
FLORIDA, REPEALING CHAPTER 30, ARTICLE 6 OF
THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, RELATING TO
CRUISING CONTROL; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
DATE.

WHEREAS the City has from time to time, has amended parts of the Code
which are no longer in use; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 30, Article 6, Code of Ordinances, prohibits cruising; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 30 Article 6, Code of Ordinances, is no longer utilized by
the Clearwater Police Department, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CLEARWATER, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Chapter 30, Article 6, Code of Ordinances, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

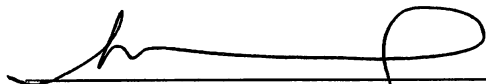
