Welcoming Public Art



With its bright colors and dancing stars, "Slow Dance" will invite visitors to stop in as they transition the area. The colorful sculpture can also act as a wayfinding device for meet ups with friends and family inviting them to enjoy the marina walkway.

SLOW DANCE


- High fire glazed porcelain, glass, & stone mosaic
- Adhered with modified thin-set cement
- Grouted with urethane grout

Steel imbedded for structural support and pick points


2 coats of acryllic cement with fiberglass reinforcement
