Welcoming Public Art

An iconic sculpture can act as a welcoming attract, beckoning visitors to a site and suggesting a feeling of arrival. At fourteen feet tall, “Slow Dance” announces the site of the Clearwater Beach Municipal Marina by welcoming visitors with its colorful, lighthearted presence.

“Slow Dance” evokes a nautical theme that includes a notice to all who enter the marina – slow down and enjoy the ride.

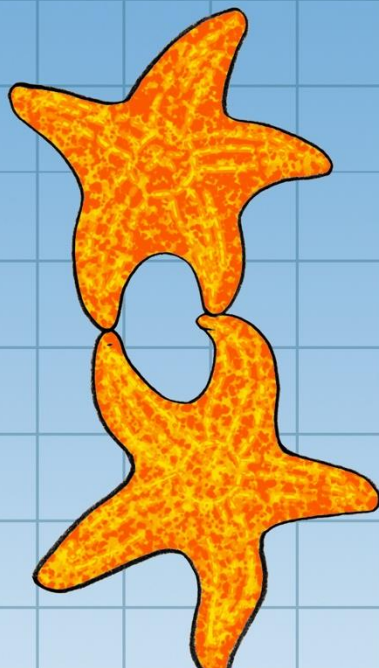
Slow, no wake, please!

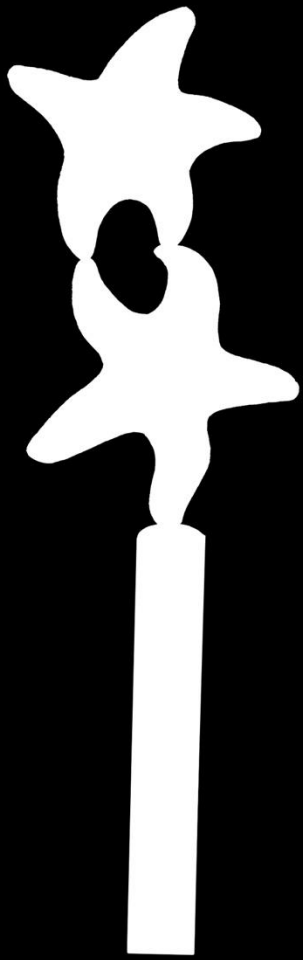

Basic Sculptural Construction for

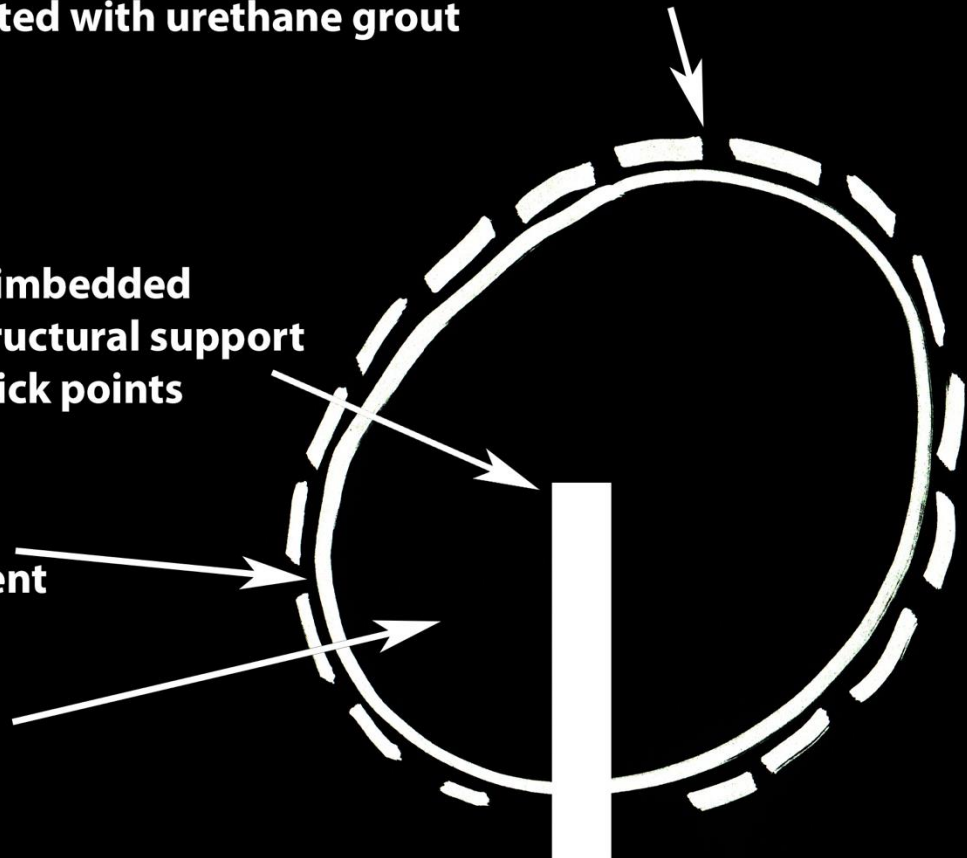
SLOW DANCE

- High fire glazed porcelain, glass, & stone mosaic
- Adhered with modified thin-set cement
- Grouted with urethane grout

for structural support

with fiberglass reinforcement**
