

ORDINANCE NO. 9678-23

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CLEARWATER, FLORIDA, REPEALING SECTION 21.15 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, RELATING TO THE OFFENSE OF REQUESTING PAYMENT IN EXCHANGE FOR "WATCHING" PARKED MOTOR VEHICLES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS the City has from time to time, has amended parts of the Code which are no longer in use; and

WHEREAS, Section 21.15, Code of Ordinances, prohibits requesting payment in exchange for "watching" parked motor vehicles; and

WHEREAS, Section 21.15, Code of Ordinances, is no longer utilized by the Clearwater Police Department, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEARWATER, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 21.15, Code of Ordinances, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
