Planned "Duck Days" Events: Exclusive Photo Opportunity - January 9th: Before the official events begin, we'll offer limited five-minute time slots for Jeep owners (and other guests) to park in front of the duck for an exclusive photo session. Participants can take their own photos using personal cameras or phones. This paid timeslot initiative will help offset event costs while generating organic promotion, as participants share their photos and tag Coachman Park on social media. - 100-200 guests Market Marie – January 10th: The well established Saturday market will be the first major weekend event for the duck. Market Marie organizers have said they can try to incorporate vendors with duck themes for this month. - 4000 guests Duck Dash 5K – January 11th: A lively morning fun run organized by the Special Events team, complete with vendors and a cheerful, family-friendly atmosphere. 175+ guests Rubber Ducky's Birthday Bash – January 17th: A celebration of National Rubber Duck Day featuring live performances by Jack Hartmann and Mr. Brad, bounce houses, face painters, balloon artists, kids' craft vendors, and plenty

of family fun. - 1000+ guests Scenes on the Green – January 23rd – Bringing back a well-established event hosted by Special Events. This edition will feature a fun duck-themed movie, with possible selections including The Mighty Ducks or DuckTales: The Movie. -100-200 guests Duck 'n' Drive Jeep Invasion – January 24th: A fullday Jeep fest celebrating Jeep culture, tying in the popular "ducking" tradition among Jeep owners. The event will include Jeep displays, live music, axe throwing, a "Touch-a-Jeep" area for kids, and local vendors. - 5000+ guests Rubber Duck Races: We are hoping to work with a local Girl or Boy Scout Troop or school to have them build a racing "track" for rubber ducks. Organization can keep all funds made from these duck races. Throughout the World's Largest Rubber Duck exhibit, visitors can enjoy photo ops, branded installations, and family activities designed to draw people downtown, boost local business engagement, and create a memorable Clearwater experience.
