We would like to begin by expressing how much we enjoy operating our business on Clearwater Beach. It has been a privilege to serve visitors and families, and we value the partnership we have built with the City.

Operating outdoors presents a very different set of challenges compared to an indoor facility. Our equipment and staff are fully exposed to the elements, which increases both labor and maintenance needs. We operate seven days a week, weather permitting, with set hours, and we work hard to maintain a safe, clean, and visually appealing environment for guests.

Because of these conditions, our annual operating expenses include:

- Labor costs: \$241,776
- Water bill: \$5,200
- Background checks: \$736
- Parking costs: \$2,064
- Turtle permit: \$200–\$500 per year (if signed and sealed additional \$500-1500)
- Higher supply, repair, and replacement costs due to weather-related wear and tear
- Full inflatable equipment and ride replacement every 18 months due to sun damage. (Hippo waterside \$125,000) (Shark slide \$15,000.00 / Obstacle Course \$4,500 / Bounce house \$4,200 / Fishpipe ball \$9,000 yearly)

We share these key items simply to provide transparency as we move into a structure that includes both a flat fee and a percentage of gross sales. With the addition of the Ferris wheel next to our location, we are excited for the growth it will bring to the beach, while also anticipating an impact on our future sales.

We appreciate your time and consideration, and we look forward to continuing our partnership and contributing positively to the Clearwater Beach experience.

We began operations in 2014 at Clearwater Beach with the Hippo Waterslide and a small selection of inflatables next to Pier 60. 




