

ORDINANCE NO. 9727-23

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CLEARWATER,
FLORIDA, REPEALING CHAPTER 21, SECTION 21.18 OF
THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, RELATING TO
SOLICITING, BEGGING, OR PANHANDLING IN THE
CLEARWATER DOWNTOWN CORE REDEVELOPMENT
ZONE AND THE CLEARWATER BEACH CORE TOURIST
ZONE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS the City has from time to time, has amended parts of the Code which are no longer in use; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 21, Section 21.18, Code of Ordinances, prohibits soliciting, begging, or panhandling in the Clearwater Downtown Core Redevelopment Zone and the Clearwater Beach Core Tourist Zone; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 21, Section 21.18, Code of Ordinances, is no longer utilized by the Clearwater Police Department, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEARWATER, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Chapter 21, Section 21.18, Code of Ordinances, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
