

RESOLUTION NO. 16-11

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEARWATER, FLORIDA, APPROVING SOVEREIGNTY SUBMERGED LAND LEASE RENEWAL NO. 520010893 WITH THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INTERNAL IMPROVEMENT TRUST FUND OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA; AUTHORIZING EXECUTION BY THE CITY MANAGER AND THE MAYOR; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Clearwater, Florida (“City”) has constructed and operates Pier 60, a public, recreational pier on Clearwater Beach extending from City-owned lands onto submerged, sovereign lands and waters of the State of Florida in the Gulf of Mexico; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund of the State of Florida (“TIIF”) has administrative authority over such submerged, sovereign lands and waters; and,

WHEREAS, the City has applied to TIIF for a 5 year renewal of the lease for such submerged, sovereign lands and waters beneath Pier 60; and,

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Public Land Administration, Division of State Lands, State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection, as agent for and on behalf of TIIF, proposes renewing such lease with the City via Sovereign Submerged Lands Lease Renewal No. 520010893, which is attached hereto as “Exhibit A;” and,

WHEREAS, said lease renewal has been duly considered by the City Council; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEARWATER, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The City Council approves renewing the agreement attached hereto in Exhibit “A” for a term of five (5) years, and the City Council finds that the City’s purpose for this lease is a valid, public one.

Section 2. The City Council authorizes both the City Manager and Mayor execute the agreement attached hereto in Exhibit “A,” on behalf of the City of Clearwater.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
