ORDINANCE NO. 9676-23

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CLEARWATER, FLORIDA, REPEALING CHAPTER 21, ARTICLE 2 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, RELATING TO THE REGISTRATION OF EX-CONVICTS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 21, Article 2, Code of Ordinances, requires a registry of exconvicts to be kept by the Clearwater Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Section 775.13, Florida Statutes, requires the county sheriff to keep a registry of convicted felons. In compliance with the statute, Pinellas County Sheriff's Office does keep a registry of convicted felons including any located the city of Clearwater; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 21, Article 2, Code of Ordinances, therefore, is redundant, and is not necessary to enforce the registry be also kept by Clearwater Police Department, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEARWATER, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Chapter 21, Article 2, Code of Ordinances, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
