It was a pleasure speaking with you in regards of the above. As mentioned, If the debris was generated during the most recent hurricanes, then the removal of the debris from the waterway may be considered exempt under the Emergency Order(s). With that being said, the contractors must still use BMPs to ensure minimal disturbances to the waterway are caused during debris removal.
