DESCRIPTION

The Recordall Disc Series meters meet or exceed the most recent revision of AWWA Standard C700 and are available in a lead-free bronze alloy. 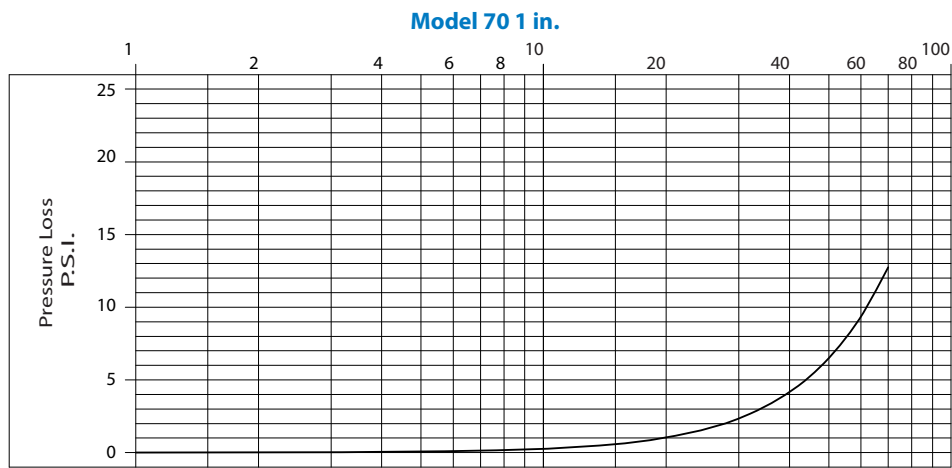
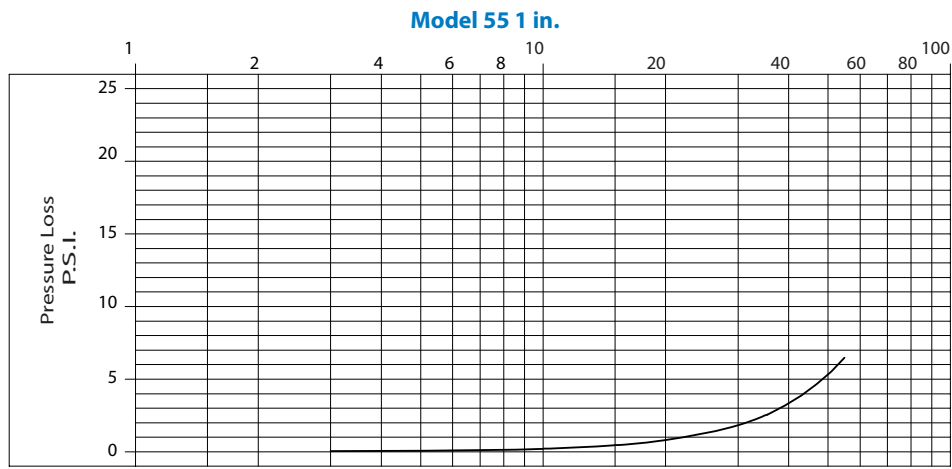
PRESSURE LOSS CHARTS

Rate of Flow in Gallons per Minute



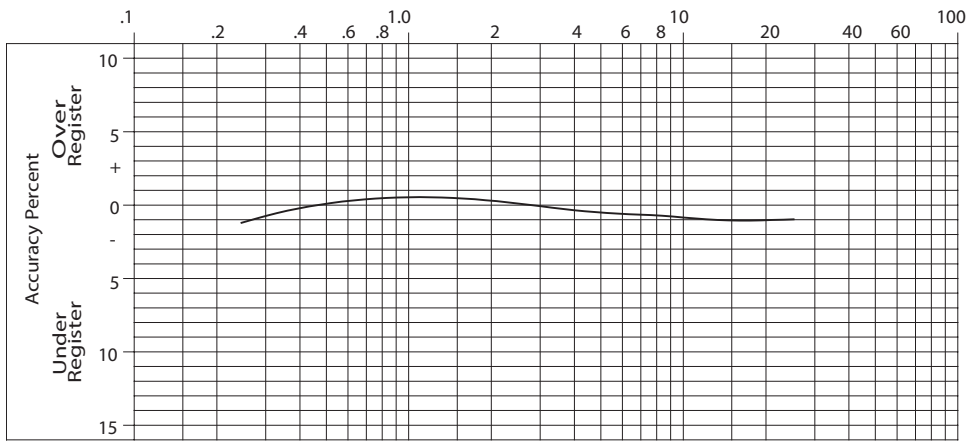

Rate of Flow in Gallons per Minute

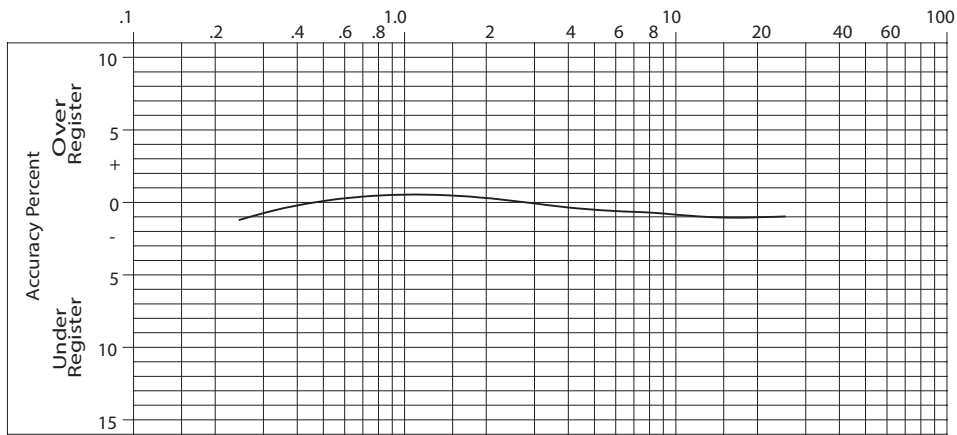

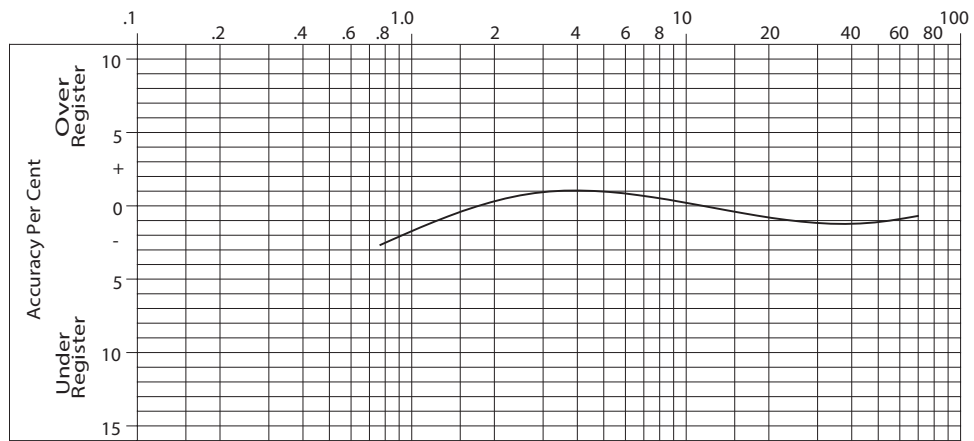

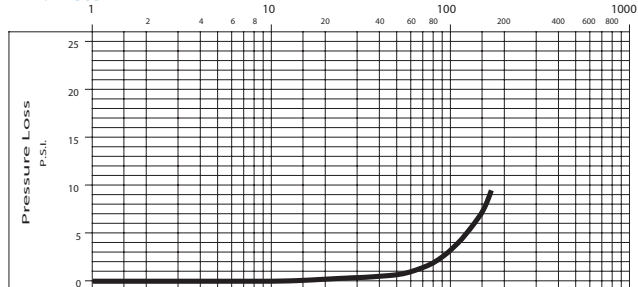
PRESSURE LOSS CHARTS

Rate of Flow in Gallons per Minute



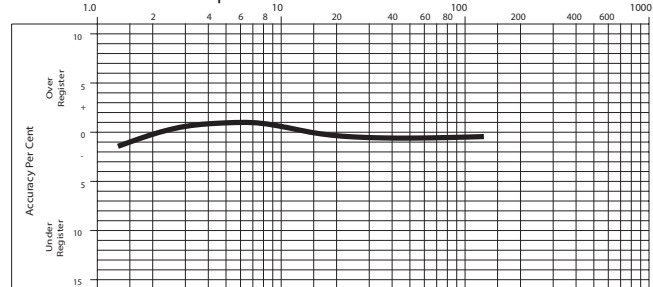
