## WHY SIGNAGE NEEDS TO BE REPLACED

- A large number of signs are:
  - Damaged
  - Have outdated information
  - Paper/temporary
  - Inconsistent













#### THE PROCESS

- Over the past three years:
  - Inventoried the different types and sizes of existing Clearwater park signs.
  - Researched other cities' park signage programs.
  - Reached out to signage companies to ask for samples, affordable signage options and the latest technologies.
  - Designed more than 100 icon options.







### STANDARD SIGNAGE



#### THE SIGNAGE

- Made with a more durable material.
- Easier to rewrap versus replace in the event of vandalism.
- Modern design.
- Include renovated park maps.
- Can be double-sided and multi-lingual. (English on one-side, Spanish on the other)



#### HOW WE ARE REDUCING COSTS

- Replacing signage as needed.
- Combining existing multiple signs into one and adding website for additional information.
- Re-evaluating what signage is needed.
- Standardizing signage for bulk orders.
- Excluding the city logo.
- Using multiple vendors.
- Working with Public Work's sign shop for basic signage.


