





## **Bay Park Option 1**

- Reinstate the permit parking program
- Issue a limited # of permits to area condos
- Allow overnight parking during peak periods
- Monitor the lot for damage and misuse

# **Bay Park Option 2**

- Pave the lot at an estimated cost of \$375,000
- Meter and enforce the lot
- Allow occasional overnight parking during peak periods at no charge
- Remove the restrictions for commercial vehicle parking

## Lot # 10 (City Hall)

- Total Spaces 127
- 51 Metered
- 6 ADA Spaces
- 70 Reserved/ Permitted Spaces
  - 20 Spaces- Capitol Theatre Valet
  - 3 Spaces- Second Century Studios
  - 10 Spaces- Water's Edge Condos
  - 4 Spaces- Ruth Eckerd Hall Employees
  - 10 Spaces- Pinellas County

# Lot # 10 (City Hall)- Cont.

- Revenue
  - FY 16/17- \$6641
  - FY 17/18- \$5989
- Special Uses
  - Event Parking
  - Free Jolley Trolley Program during Spring
    Break

#### **CMA Lot**

- Currently a grass lot with wheel stops
- Estimated 130 spaces
- Currently used for special events and Free Jolley Trolley program during Spring Break
- If the CMA Lot is to be used for daily transient parking it would need to brought up to code compliance standards

### **CMA Lot- Cont.**

- Estimated cost to bring the CMA Lot to compliance
  \$400,000
- Additional cost for metering and lighting
