On March 12, 2019, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved Resolution 19-14 which set the following disposal rate for the disposal of municipal solid waste, commercial waste, and yard waste:

The fee for Approved Solid Waste be increased from the current rate of \$37.50 per ton to:

1. \$39.75 per ton effective October 1, 2019
2. \$42.15 per ton effective October 1, 2020
3. \$44.70 per ton effective October 1, 2021

Disposal Rate Increase: Effective October 1, 2020, is \$42.15 per ton

Fee Increases:

The following fee increases will take effect October 1, 2020 when the Department of Solid Waste's budget receives final approval from the BCC on September 22, 2020:

1. Tire Fee increases from \$75 to \$110 per ton (tire fee is applicable to any load containing five or more waste tires; reweigh is required)
2. Flat fee for cars increases from \$3.00 to \$4.00 per load
3. Flat fee for pick-ups and vans increases from \$10.00 to \$11.00 per load
4. Out-of-County Waste Surcharge is applied at \$42.15 per ton in addition to the per ton rate of \$42.15.

No Fee Change:

1. Special Handling Service Fee remains \$110 per load in addition to per ton rate
2. Contractor Surcharge Fee remains \$100 per load in addition to the per ton rate
3. Christmas Tree Disposal Fee remains \$3 per load for up to five Christmas trees
