# **Bike Racks/Kiosks**


Staff is developing plans for the installation of new bike racks along the 400–700 blocks of Cleveland Street.

# Reimagine Clearwater – Main Library Redevelopment


The City of Clearwater received **6 submissions** in response to the *Reimagine Clearwater Main Library* Call for Development Concepts.

### **Next Steps:**


- Aug 1: Top 3 proposals selected by Review

### **Tranche 3 – Washington Ave & MLK Site**

- 7-parcel multifamily site to be released in August
- Phase I Environmental Study required and in progress

#### **Tranche 2 – North Greenwood CRA Parcels**

- 2 offers received:
  - 1164 LaSalle Street
  - 4-parcel site near Curtis Elementary
- TRC to review proposals on July 28
