TO THE
2021 PINELLAS COUNTY
TECHNICAL RESCUE TEAM AGREEMENT
CITY OF CLEARWATER

This Renewal No. 1 ("Renewal") to the 2021 Pinellas County Technical Rescue Team Agreement, as amended by Amendment No. 1 (collectively, the "Agreement"), is entered into this _____ day of _____, 2026, by and between the City of Clearwater, a Florida municipal corporation ("Contractor"), and Pinellas County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, through its Board of County Commissioners ("County") (individually, "Party"; collectively, "Parties").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into the Agreement effective October 1, 2021, for an initial term of five (5) years, ending at midnight September 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement authorizes the Parties to renew the Agreement for one or more additional renewal periods, each of not less than one (1) year nor more than five (5) years, provided the aggregate of all renewal periods does not exceed five (5) years in total; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to renew the Agreement for an initial renewal period of one (1) year, commencing October 1, 2026 and ending at midnight September 30, 2027, with up to four (4) additional years of renewal capacity remaining pursuant to Amendment No. 1; and

WHEREAS, the Parties have the authority to renew the Agreement pursuant to Section 801 thereof, as amended.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants expressed herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

ARTICLE I

RENEWAL OF AGREEMENT

SECTION 1.01. Renewal Term. The Agreement is hereby renewed for a period of one (1) year, commencing upon October 1, 2026 and ending at midnight September 30, 2027 ("Renewal Term"), unless earlier terminated in accordance with the terms of the Agreement. This Renewal No. 1 constitutes the first renewal period exercised under Amendment No. 1, and the aggregate remaining renewal capacity available to the Parties pursuant to Amendment No. 1 following this Renewal shall be four (4) years.

SECTION 1.02. Terms and Conditions. Except as otherwise expressly set forth herein, all terms and conditions of the Agreement, including but not limited to all compensation, reimbursement, insurance, and performance obligations, shall remain in full force and effect during the Renewal Term and are hereby ratified and confirmed by the Parties.

SECTION 1.03. Compensation. Compensation and reimbursement to the Contractor during the Renewal Term shall be governed by Article VII of the Agreement and subject to the County's annual budget adoption process for Fiscal Year 2026–2027 in accordance with Section 705 of the Agreement. No payment may be compelled or made in excess of the amount authorized through the County's approved budget for the Renewal Term.

SECTION 1.04. Subsequent Renewals. Nothing in this Renewal No. 1 shall obligate either Party to exercise any subsequent renewal period. Any further renewal of the Agreement following the expiration of the Renewal Term shall be subject to the mutual written agreement of the Parties pursuant to Section 801 of the Agreement, as amended by Amendment No. 1, and shall require approval no less than thirty (30) days prior to the expiration of the then-current term.

ARTICLE II
GENERAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 2.01. Effect of Renewal. This Renewal, together with the Agreement and Amendment No. 1, constitutes the entire and complete agreement of the Parties with respect to the Renewal Term. In the event of any conflict between the provisions of this Renewal and the provisions of the Agreement or Amendment No. 1, the provisions of this Renewal shall control solely with respect to the Renewal Term.

SECTION 2.02. Counterparts. This Renewal may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which, taken together, shall constitute one and the same instrument.

SECTION 2.03. Governing Law. This Renewal shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida.
