Final allocation will be based upon the 2017 Entitlement

* HOUSING POOL FUNDING

- > \$2.5 million
- > Available throughout the Fiscal Year
- > May make application anytime during the Fiscal Year
- > Available for those opportunities identified after the application cycle
- > Allow minimum of 90 days to begin the project



* SHIP FUNDING

- \$15,166 available for Homebuyer Education
- > Must be HUD Certified Homebuyer Counseling Agency
- > Will be available throughout the year
- > Ineligible Activities
 - Foreclosure Prevention Counseling
 - Fair Housing Counseling
