Mr. Horne,

After additional review with Ms. Akin, I submit the following for the agenda item discussion on next Tuesday. Additionally I am attaching two photos for attachment to this agenda item.

- Action Recommendation: Direct staff to take foreclosure recommendations to the Municipal Code of Enforcement Board (MCEB) <u>where appropriate</u> and bring authorization to file suit to the Council when recommended by the MCEB.
- 2. Background: Clearwater has 145 Code Enforcement Liens with a value of over \$19 million dollars which continue to accrue fines many in the hundreds of thousands of dollars.
- 3. Blighted conditions from some of these properties have continued for years with negative affect the surrounding properties and neighborhood. Foreclosure may be appropriate as a last means of achieving code compliance.
- See attached two photos for one example of this situation located at 309 S. Pegasus with \$626,400 of accrued fines. This lien dates from 2008. The photos show the property unchanged from August 2016 to August 2017.
