

**CITY OF CLEARWATER
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
PENNY FOR PINELLAS PROJECTS
CITY COUNCIL MEETING
Thursday, September 6, 2018
6:00 p.m.**

A public hearing will be held by the City of Clearwater, in City Council Chambers, in City Hall, 3rd floor, 112 South Osceola Avenue, Clearwater, Florida, regarding the Penny for Pinellas project list for fiscal years 2018/19 through 2019/20 totaling \$14,953,710 to fund capital projects under the Penny for Pinellas Plan.

Significant changes to the plan include:

- Ruth Eckerd Hall – This project has been established in the amount of \$3 million to be funded in fiscal year 2018/2019 and 2019/2020. This funding will provide for specific capital improvements and enhancements necessary for the renovation, repair and operation of this City owned facility.
- Downtown Intermodal Facility – This project is being eliminated from the project list due to the postponement of the project shifting it outside of this Penny cycle. This represents a decrease of \$2,425,000 in Penny for Pinellas funding planned in fiscal year 2019/2020.
- Crest Lake Park Improvements – This project is being funded with settlement funds from the BP Deepwater Horizon oil spill, which eliminates the need for Penny funds. This represents a decrease of \$750,000 in Penny for Pinellas funding planned in fiscal year 2018/2019.

Interested parties may appear and be heard at the hearing or file written notice of approval or objection with the City Clerk prior to the hearing. Any person who decides to appeal any decision made by the Council, with respect to any matter considered at such hearing, will need a record of the proceedings and, for such purpose, may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based per Florida Statute 286.0105.

All individuals speaking on public hearing items will be sworn in.
