Four Steps to the Desired Outcome

- 1. Commit to an 18-month strategy with a defined focus and measurable outcomes
 - 2. Communicate the strategy
 - 3. Implement the strategy
 - 4. Track and publish results*
 - *Repeat steps two through four for 18 months

CRA 18-Month Strategy

- Create and share authentic, positive stories about Downtown Clearwater
- 2. Begin construction on Imagine Clearwater
- 3. Permit 600 housing units
- 4. Attract \$100 million dollars of private investment


