DIVISION 10. - PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD[12]

Sec. 2.231. - Creation.

There is hereby created the parks and recreation board.

(Code 1980, § 116.20)

• Sec. 2.232. - Composition.

The parks and recreation board shall consist of seven members.

Sec. 2.233. - Terms of members.

The members of the parks and recreation board shall serve for four-year staggered terms, staggered such that not more than three terms shall expire in any calendar year.

Sec. 2.234. - Powers and duties.

The parks and recreation board shall consult with and advise the city manager and other municipal officers regarding the physical condition of, improvements on, and beautification of the public parks and playgrounds; shall serve in an advisory capacity in connection with all public parks, parkways, playgrounds, athletic fields, bathing beaches, and all other property owned or controlled by the city and used for public purposes; shall make recommendations regarding the development of city property as public parks and playgrounds; and shall submit reports to the city commission regarding their recommendations.
