**Question 3.** What background, experience, or education qualifies you to serve on the Board(s)?


Answer 3. \* As a transportation planner I gained experience in reviewing and creating planning documents against criteria. As a president of the CNC I worked to identify community needs, to review documents and to work with the city in two-way communication on public issues. I was on the Imagine Clearwater committee and I attended public information events, advocating for its public approval. I also worked with the CNC to develop a needs assessment for Complete Streets, for which we are still active.

**Question 4.** Why do you want to serve on the Board(s)?

Answer 4. \* I believe that I could assist in establishing a two way communication effort between neighborhoods and the CDB. The CDB makes decisions which affect neighborhoods but there is a feeling among neighborhoods that their perspectives need to be addressed and considered earlier in the planning process. There is a new public education document developed by the planning department that will help explain how the CDB works and how to present issues. It will help a great deal, but having someone on the board who understand the needs of neighborhoods is also important.
