SUBJECT/RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize a purchase order to Palmdale Oil Company of Ft. Pierce, FL to provide oils and lubricants for a not to exceed amount of \$225,000 for period October 1, 2020 through July 31, 2023 with one additional two-year renewal at a not to exceed amount of \$150,000 at the City’s discretion, pursuant to Clearwater Code of Ordinances Section 2.564(1)(d) Cooperative Contracts and authorize the appropriate officials to execute same. (consent)

SUMMARY:

In April 2020, the City of St. Petersburg, FL issued a Cooperative Bid No., IFB 7654, Oils and Lubricants in which the City was a participant along with several other local municipalities.

This cooperative agreement will allow the City to take advantage of various oils and lubricants required for the maintenance of city-wide vehicles at bulk discount pricing.

The estimated annual amount per year will be \$75,000 under this contract.
